- Water Management (Recycle/ Reduce / Reuse) by Mr. Rahul Sonawane from ITT Corporation of India.

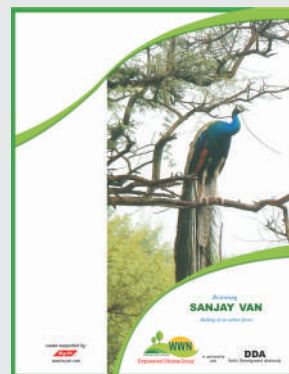
